The Cambridge AICE Diploma

Students may earn the prestigious Cambridge AICE Diploma by passing seven AICE exams across the three subject areas and including Global Perspectives and Research. Successful completion of seven AICE courses in pursuit of the AICE Diploma qualifies students to receive the Tennessee High School Diploma with Distinction.

Minimum 7 credits. Credit for Global Perspectives AS is required for the Diploma along with at least one credit from Groups 1, 2, and 3. One credit is earned for each exam passed with a score of A-E.
